Technology Tip of the Month

Do you know how to access your library account from your home computer? It's easy! All you have to do is go to the library webpage at lib.williamson-tn.org, then click on the "My Library Account" link on the left side of the page. You will be asked to type your name, library card number, and a personal identification number, or PIN. The PIN is a string of at least four numbers, known only to yourself, that serves as a security protection so that no one else can access your account. Be sure it's something that you can easily remember, but someone else would have a hard time guessing!

Once you've entered a PIN and then confirmed it, you can access your account. Next month, we'll learn some of the things you can do within your account.
